Welcome back – staff, governors and I hope that you have had a good and restful Easter break.

## Staff and children

This term we welcome Mr Cuff, our new Deputy Headteacher to the Year 4 classroom – we all look forward to getting to know him. Given the unexpected changes for the Year 4 class this year, I have decided that Mr Cuff will stay with the class as they move into Year 5 in September. At that point, Miss Norfolk will move to Year 4. Other teaching staff will remain in their current year group. I would not normally publish this information until July but do this so that Year 4 children can be spared further changes. Decisions about the deployment of Teaching Assistants will be made nearer the time.

In terms of pupil numbers, we have 209 of a possible 210 children and a waiting list for a number of year groups.

## Events this half-term

In addition to the usual and packed programme of extra-curricular activities learning is enriched through trips and visits; for Year 4 (Wandlebury and Prick Willow Museum) and Year 6 (St John's College). This term's regional sports' events are a netball tournament and a school games event. PTA events will feature a challenging fundraising activity for families and staff and its annual much-loved Summer Fair - please save the dates. ## Learning this half-term

Over this half term, Maths learning in each class will be observed by Mr Cuff and me. Teaching staff will benefit from visits to each others' classrooms to share good and outstanding practice in teaching and learning. In addition, the school's advisors Ms West (Local Authority) and Mrs Lowery (Diocese) will visit the school giving the children opportunities to demonstrate their best thinking and learning. Last but not least, Years 6 and 2 will sit the Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) in May. They have been well prepared for these, so although they will continue to need to give their best focus and concentration to these, they should not be alarmed, as per the advice given in the Years 2 & 6 Parent Briefings last term.
