Year 4 class assembly

Year 4 parents/carers are very welcome to join us on Friday for your child's class assembly. Please sign in at the school office for a prompt start at 1.30pm. The children are looking forward to making their presentation to you. A parent briefing will follow then a visit to our celebration assembly will complete your afternoon. We look forward to welcoming you.

Punctuality

Please support your child to arrive in school on time; that is **before 8.55am**. We have noticed an unfortunate trend of lateness for some children over the last few weeks which have become very disruptive to classes, the office and the kitchen.

I have re-attached the punctuality criteria we use. As you know this is commented on (green, amber, red) in your child's termly report. It is really important that your child arrives promptly at 8.45am for the following reasons:

- to take advantage of the learning activity set for between 8.45 and 8.55am
- to hear the timetable for the day and any changes
- so that they are ready for guided reading at 9.00am
- so that learning is not disrupted for others
- so that meal numbers and choices are able to be processed by the office and passed to the kitchen on time for 9.15am at the latest
- so that the work of the school office is not disrupted

Families arriving after 8.55am **must** report to the school office, as the register in class is closed and the teacher will be introducing the day ahead before quickly starting guided reading groups for 9.00am. **The green gates to classrooms are bolted at 8.55am for specific safety reasons and should not be re-opened by parents or children after this time. Thank you for your support in this.**

Instrumentalists' Concert

This is a wonderful annual concert at which children learning an instrument in school with our peripatetic teachers give an individual performance to parents. This concert will take place on Thursday 30th March, starting at 7.00pm.

Wellies

Please consider sending a pair of wellies for your child to use at lunchtime, should they wish to go in the meadow. These can be stored on the class welly stand in the playground. You child's class teacher can help your child to organise this. One parent has informed me that wellies have perished having been out all year - please

be assured that we are looking in to this and are trying to source an appropriate cover solution for the storage stands so that wellies can be recycled and handed down to save waste and money.

Church Street issues

As we approach the new financial year, in which the works on Church Street are proposed to be completed, I understand that further consultation is expected to take place with villagers – please look out for the chance to comment on these proposals. In advance of any other works, it is very good to have the long overdue renewal of the yellow zig-zag signs from the Parish Council/County Highways Department.

The Parish Council hopes to install flashing warning signs, and has contacted the school about this. Whilst the governors are very much in favour of the signs, and representative governors are contributing to a report to support the Council's bid, they do not believe that school funds can or should be used on this village expenditure. Governors wish to share this information with the parent body in order to avoid potential future miscommunication on this issue. For convenience, the following is taken from the last Governing Board minutes:

"Following the survey conducted in 2015/2016 by Great Shelford Parish Council (GSPC), the parish council is applying for a grant to erect a flashing '20 mph/school' sign on Church Street. They have requested a 10% contribution from the school, amounting to £1,000. Governors felt strongly that this should be paid for by the Parish Council and that neither the school nor the PTA should contribute to this. It was noted that the school is not permitted to spend school funds on non-school items."
