Covid Guideline Changes

As you will be aware, changes to Covid guidelines came into effect on 1st April 2022.

This means that people who are unwell or have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with others. Pupils can return to school when they are well enough **and** have no temperature.

With this change, it means we now record all absence as illness and no longer use a Covid related code on our registers. We will not be providing home learning for pupils that are unwell – as pupils that are not well enough to attend school are not expected to complete learning activities – just as before Covid.
