Dear parents and carers,

I am glad to share information with you regarding choosing Great and Little Shelford CE (A) Primary School for your child to begin Reception in September 2025. Firstly, I hope that you and your family are well and that you enjoy exploring the idea of starting school next year. It may feel like a long way away, but sharing ideas about it now is a great way to help inform your decision.

We are a very warm and nurturing primary school with a planned roll of 210 pupils. We are exceptionally proud of our school and the unique community that has been embedded with pupils, parents, staff and governors. In addition to this, we are very proud of our heritage and village links. Looking further afield, we have an International Schools Award for the outstanding development of the international dimension of the curriculum. This enables our pupils to understand more about how they belong to a global community – including communicating with children across the world in our many partner schools. We have a range of further specialisms and awards, some of which are referenced in our admissions materials for this year.
