As you will know, we will be holding Virtual Parent and Teacher Consultations this Autumn. Some key points are below:

- The booking and video consultation will take place through School Cloud a system designed for Parents' Consultations.
- Consultations are scheduled for 10 minutes and the system automatically ends the meeting at that duration. As per the grid above, we aim for a continued dialogue around your child's learning. Therefore, please touch base with us if you have additional points to raise.
- The system will also email you 1 hour before the consultation to remind you of your session.
- If your child is in Y3 or Y4, the consultation will be with one of the class teachers not both.
